A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun or nouns. The words **he, she, it, we, you, and they** are pronouns.

**Carlos** is a vet. **He** helps animals.  
**He** takes the place of the noun **Carlos**.

**Keesha** and **Paul** are zookeepers. **They** also help animals.  
**They** takes the place of the nouns **Keesha** and **Paul**.

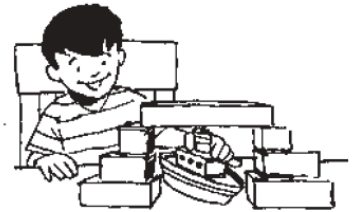
